## Orientation on Monitoring and Evaluation

A 4 days Orientation was held at CHAI office Secundrabad from 31<sup>st</sup> October to 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2017. 20 staff members from Central Office and 5 Regional Program Officer from MPSSS, Delhi, Kerala, and West Bengal were part of the orientation. Orientation was held on Monitoring and Evaluation. As the project is in its new phase the staffs were oriented on effective monitoring and evaluation in respective area of work, so that proper implementation of the project can take place. Various queries of the staffs were addressed during the orientation.



Networking with organizations of par excellence



A two day's networking and linkage visit was done to the organizations with par excellence by Director-MPSSS on 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> November 2017, at Kerala. First day visit was made to Kerala Social Service Forum in Kottayam, where he also visited "CHAITANYA" one of the partners of KSSF and a leading self financed organization. Next day he visited Social Action Forum Irinjalakuda (SAFI) where MPSSS Director had discussion on micro finance ventures and other thematic areas of work.

## A platform of Learning & Sharing with communities

PLD staff did monitoring visits to Satna from 7th to 9th November & 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2017 to Raisen District of Sagar. Zonal Coordinator of Central Zone Mr.Ramesh & 2 Program Officers from MPSSS were part of the visits. Objective of the visit was to visit the project implementation area to monitor the process & its impact on the community. First two days 9 villages of Satna & Sagar dioceses were visited this included interactions with the community. Communities shared information on work done for the village development. Voluntary actions of communities were real source of inspiration. Third day the entire team had a discussion on the observations of the field visits.



## Awareness creation on Health

Two days awareness creation on health was done in the communities by Regional Health Coordinator of MPSSS from 16th to 17th November 2017. 2 villages Mayan Gaon and Lalpur of Satna Diocese were visited for acquainting the present health scenario. Visit brought out the reality that Mayan goan anganwadi was situated in other village which was far away from Mayan
