### Health Monitoring visit to Sagar

2 days monitoring visit was done to Diocese of Sagar on 6th and 7th October 2017 by MPSSS Regional Health Coordinator. The objective of the visit was to learn the circumstances of the health centres and other health initiatives in the diocese. A Meeting was done with Fr. Antony, Director Health Initiatives in the Diocese of Sagar, and discussions were held about the various health programmes and health centers. In Field visits interactions with the adolescent girls and SHG women was held and discussed on community

health status, issues like hygiene, healthy food habits and equal care of boy and girl child and their education, TB, eye check-up, HIV, leprosy etc were also discussed.



### Re positioning was done by the Directors



A meeting was organized by MPSSS with Directors and Coordinators of 9 DSSSSs on 13th October 2017. 14 of them were part of the discussions. Objective of the meeting was to have an orientation for the future. Various thematic areas and issue of concerns were discussed. Re-visiting the goals and objectives were the prime intentions of the meeting.

### Ongoing Project Monitoring visit to IDSSS (Indore) & ANWC (Bhopal) was conducted by MPSSS

Monitoring visit was done to IDSSS, Indore & ANWC, Bhopal from 23 to 24 October 2017 & 26<sup>th</sup> October respectively. 4 villages being visited Chamar Mohalla, Bercha, Anandnagar of Indore and Bhilai village of Nasrullaganj block of ANWC in which interaction was held with the community people. Objective of the visit was to visit the project implementation area & monitor the process of the project & its impact on the community. An interaction with the team enabled the discussion on areas of improvement & performance of community facilitators. Experience sharing was done by the community people about the various works they had undertaken for the development of the villages.



### Capacity Enhancement on coordination, facilitation, conflict resolution and self evaluation



Two days capacity enhancement was done of Kripa Staffs. Training was on Coordination, Facilitation, Conflict resolution and Self evaluation which was held at Kripa training centre Ujjain from 24<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> October 2017. Total numbers of participants were 58. The objective of the training was to clarify and

introspect on the concepts that are practiced at the field. Each staff gained knowledge from the training which they share in their feedback which will be useful further in their work.

### Orientation Programme to Regional Units on Community Health Project-Phase III



2 days new phase orientation on IIIrd phase of community health project took place at CHAI office, Secundrabad from 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> October 2017. Director MPSSS & Regional Program Officer were part of the meeting. Overall six regional Director's, Regional Program Officer's & CHAI Staffs were part of the meeting. Objective was- to orient the Regional Directors and Regional Programme Officers on Community Health Project Phase- III, activities, sharing and

explanation of the project reporting format and to facilitate Regional Units to develop action plan for the next three months.

### MPSSS staff orientation on O D process

One day MPSSS staff being oriented on organizational development and documentation on 31<sup>st</sup> October 2017. Fr.Jacob CMI from Indore was the resource person who gave the orientation. Firstly the Vision, Mission and objectives and of the organization was revisited and the role of MPSSS in today's context being clarified. Secondly staff being oriented on Impact, Outcomes and Outputs so that it can be well documented at every stage of the projects for better visibility.
