Pisciculture follow-up visit

Two days visit for Follow-up of pisciculture in the selective villages was held and interactions were also organized with the people in those three villages namely *Jamaniya*, *Talai* & *Parnali* of Meghnagar block, Jhabua district on 17th & 18th January 2024. The discussions were held on the maintenance and the results of the initiatives and the



beneficiaries informed that they are looking after the ponds properly and the fish seeds are growing. Mostly towards the end of April they will be able to sell the fish and gain the profit.

Ms. Natasha Sharma from PLDP team of MPSSS personally visited and monitored the ponds. On second day another 2 villages

named *Naharpura & Kaliya Viran* were visited where new ponds were dug in which pisciculture has to be started in coming months post rains.

Dindori visit for Video Documentation

On 11th & 12th January 2024 a visit was held at *Dindori* for identification of volunteer for the support in video documentation of *Baiga & Gond* tribes. Mr. Rahul Suryavanshi from PLDP team of MPSSS has been coordinating the documentation work during the phase. During the visit discussions were held with the local people especially the elders from the community who are well aware of their culture and various festivals related the aforesaid tribes. And possible dates for the video documentation were also finalized in consultation with the local people during the visit.



Manos Unidas Agency visit

On 3rd February 2024 representatives from Manos Unidas, Spain namely Mr. Miguel and Mrs. Maria visited MPSSS office as part of their field visits to different parts of Madhya Pradesh. An interactive session was held with them from 6 PM onwards whereby they learnt about the organizational projects and other initiatives. Fr.
