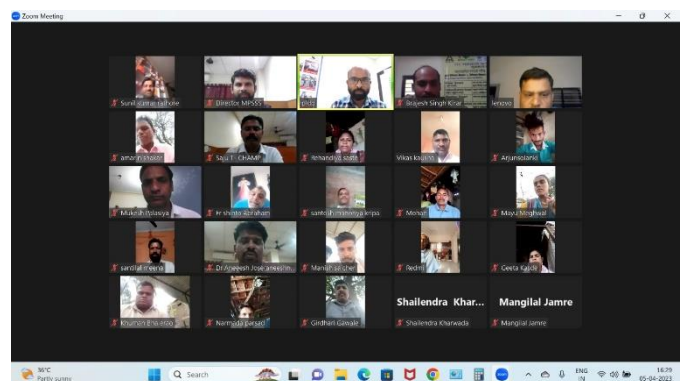
One day cross learning, sharing and reflection on best practices
